

## COMPANY K MAN KILLED IN ACTION, NOTE SAYS.

A letter was received Saturday by C. E. Humphreys from his son, Harry Humphreys, member of Co. D, 151st Machine Gun Battalion, stating that a comrade, Julius Lyons, Co. D, 151st Machine Gun Battalion, had been killed in action on the front lines in France. The family of Jacob Lyons 711 North Lime street, were prostrated upon learning of the death of their son. Lyons, who was twenty two years of age, was killed when a piece of shrapnel from a bursting shell struck him on the head. He was buried close to where he fell. A brother, Sylvester, is now in a hospital
